Located immediately south of the Eradu North Road, this house is of brick construction with a hipped corrugated iron roof. The front verandah has been enclosed with brick and there is a brick lean-to at the rear. Windows to the south elevation have feature brick arches over and rendered sills, while there are replacement aluminium framed windows to the north. The roof is punctuated by two simple rendered chimneys.
