W. Padbury was the first title holder of VL 179. He sold the block to F.W. Pearson in 1873. By 1904 the block was occupied by John M. Bone. It was part of the Estate of F.W. Pearson (Bones Farm) purchased by Mr Pearse [GE 12/02/1904].
