"The house is located in a landscaped setting, square in plan, with verandahs all round, under a hipped roof. The verandahs all round, under a hipped roof. The verandah has a concrete floor, some lattice screens and concrete block infill for a kitchen at the rear. Windows are timber sash with concrete lintels and rendered sills. Concrete blocks are patterned. Apart from the verandah infill, the building is as constructed and has high integrity.
