### One Minute Presentations from Participants

After the table deliberations were completed, Summit participants were given the opportunity to address the whole room regarding the non-mandatory services. This gave participants the chance to share their passion and hear how much certain services are valued. Each participant had 1 minute to address the room.

#### Soap Box Topics:

- a) Community Grants: support this service as it helps attract funds from other sources such as government. For a small investment, there is quite a large return that can be leveraged for the community.
- b) #86 Sports Engagement: Club Development Officer position gets \$50,000 in funding from the Dept of Sport and Rec and helps facilitate Kidsport.
- c) Events: Value of significant events to the economy/city is \$450,000 in accommodation/day if all full.
- d) Arts, Culture Heritage Events Funding: Support this service as there are lots of volunteers who give their time (ACDC) to benefit the community. ACDC only has one staff member at only 16hrs/week.
- e) Support business models for delivery – Arts Culture and Youth. Devolve to the community as they are connected and engaged. EOI process – tender for success at half the cost.
- f) #11 Heritage: It who we are, rich history – ongoing resource invest in it every year to keep it in the library.
- g) Oral History: look after heritage buildings.
- h) Strategic things under the line: Reconciliation Committee, Vibrancy – don't drop strategic projects.
- i) Art: Important. Art Centre. Seniors do a lot of art. Maintain arts and culture funding.
- j) #86 Sports Engagement: Clubs should run facilities as a business not as clubs and Sports Engagement helps this happen.
- k) Support Community: Harmony Day, Reconciliation Committee, history, heritage.
- l) Rubbish in the streets – kids no manners, make people feel welcome.
- m) Bush projects. River crossing at Walkaway School. No mobile phone reception at Ellendale Pool. Oral history and sport important.
- n) Chapman River Regional Park restoration and prevent more damage. Support sustainability, the Community Nursery and horticulture.
