#### A permit will not be granted:

If there is an intention to burn the following products as these create a smoke nuisance and a health hazard;

- Green plant material or wet material.
- Plastics, Tyres, Chemical Containers, Petroleum Products.
- Animal Manure.

OR

- The waste is on or has come from a land development site greater than 2020m<sup>2</sup> (e.g. clearing prior to subdivision of land), unless authorisation by the Council and Chief Bush Fire Control Officer.
- There are other means of removing the material.
