Mail: Cheques made payable to the City of Greater Geraldton.

BPay: Details are located on bottom of Rates Notice.

Internet: BPoint on our website at www.cgg.wa.gov.au

In-person: At the Civic Centre, Mullewa District Office or any Australia Post Office / Agency. A copy of your rate notice will be required to make payment.

eRates: Sign up via erateswa.com/greatergeraldton

RATE CATEGORIES

The City of Greater Geraldton will have three rate categories in 2026/27:

Residential: Any GRV rated property that is used for residential purposes

Non-Residential: Any GRV rated property that is used for non-residential purposes

UV: All UV rated properties

DIFFERENTIAL GENERAL RATES 2026/27	RATE IN THE DOLLAR (CENTS)	MINIMUM PAYMENTS PER ASSESSMENT
GRV Residential	10.8291	\$1,360
GRV Non-Residential	13.5530	\$1,360
UV	0.4150	\$1,360

Note: the rates-in-the-dollar and minimum payment amount adopted by Council differ from those advertised in the Notice of Intention due to new UV valuations and further considerations to revenue requirements.

Objects and reasons for differential rates

Each category reflects the level of rating required to raise the necessary revenue for Council to operate efficiently and provide the diverse range of services, programs, associated infrastructure and facilities required for the whole of the City of Greater Geraldton. The minimum payments have been determined by Council on the basis that all ratepayers must make a reasonable contribution to the cost of local government services and facilities.

Valuations

Landgate have provided updated valuations for UV properties effective from 1 July 2026, with an average % increase of 16.7%. The rate-in-the-dollar has been adjusted down to account for these movements in valuations.

Rubbish removal charges

The standard rubbish service (domestic and commercial) charge for 2026/27 has been set at \$455 per bin, serviced weekly.
