Meeting the Challenge

BUDGET 2022/23

As costs continue to rise across the globe, we're meeting the challenge of everyday living expenses to ensure Greater Geraldton remains a great place to live, work, play, study and invest.

This year we have seen state rental revaluations increase by 20%, which is a reflection of the bolstered property market. Locally, we have managed to reduce our rate-in-the-dollar by 16% to deliver a modest rate rise of 3.6% across the City of Greater Geraldton.

This will result in many ratepayers seeing small decreases in their rates notices, however this

reduction will not eliminate the reality that some property valuations have gone up a lot higher than others and above the average - meaning some households will see a rate rise this year above 3.6%.

Over the last few years we have kept rate increases to all-time lows, which is part of our ongoing commitment to our community.

The 3.6% increase is a measured response to the current economy, and allows us to keep delivering projects and priorities that our community asks for.
