

Update #4 Thursday 6 May 2021.

Yuna have welcomed Blaze Aid to the community and they are now on the ground working across the region, focussing on reinstatement of damaged/lost fencing. Blaze Aid is a volunteer-based organisation that works with families and individuals in rural Australia after natural disasters. Working alongside the rural families, these volunteers help to rebuild fences and other structures that have been damaged or destroyed.

Blaze Aid volunteers travel to a dedicated site and establish a 'base camp' for eight weeks to six months. From this base camp, the volunteers then travel in teams of 4-5 with a trailer each day to local farms and assist with fencing and structure rebuilds. Work is prioritised in order of urgency, such as stock security, boundary fencing etc.

## Do you need Blaze Aid's help?

The City has have commenced visits to rural community members and farmers to conduct welfare checks and to see if residents have power lines down in paddocks, condition of livestock, how much fencing needs replacing, if other accommodation is available and so forth. Over 40 properties have been visited in Bringo, Moonyoonooka and Mullewa and will continue throughout various areas. Names and contact details have been passed on to them from those that have been in touch with the City about your property needs.
