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	Local company commented at AD2014 that they were disappointed that a local production company was not first priority for the production. Regardless still no response to correspondence.		
	Dan Reid and the Soul Groove have been put forward as the headline act from VIP entertainment.		
	JP – Looking at changing the line-up in the 1pm – 5pm time slot. To have local dance companies perform as this will attract as larger audience.		
	JP – produced draft program for foreshore locations		
	VG – trying to get more of the community together to help with events. Preoccupied with the swim, more help needed with the kids' activities		
	YL – commented that they have received their first nomination for Australia Day awards		
	SL – Perth Company – responsible for the monster Ball etc expand the space from the basketball court to in front of the Yacht Club. Encourage more sporting groups to come on board. Have tried previously but focus on benefits of promoting their sports rather than providing entertainment. Suggest Basketball Competition
