	Due to Murray Smith (presenter), Bushfire Risk Management Officer with the Department of Fire and Emergency Services being involved in the current Witcherena fires the agency presentation will be deferred to a later meeting. Hayley Williamson (LEMC Executive Officer) takes this opportunity to brief the committee on the current status of the Witcherena fire which started in the early hours of Tuesday, 15 February 2016, consuming around 800 hectares of bushland in the Witcherena locality. Currently there are between 25 to 30 fire crews on location, installing containment lines and attending to continuous flare ups in windy and hot conditions. The Geraldton —
