This does not include invited or optional attendees. The allowance shall be paid on a per meeting attended basis in arrears. The Committee Member will be reimbursed for child care and travel expenses to the extent determined by the Salaries and Allowances Tribunal (s.5.100(5)(a)). Note: Child care costs will not be paid where the care is provided by a member of the immediate family or relative living in the same premises as the Committee Member. 2.3. No other expenses incurred by a Committee Member in performing a function under the express authority of the local government and in their capacity as a Committee Member are approved for reimbursement (s.5.100(4)(b)).
