Prominently situated on the corner of the Geraldton-Mt Magnet Road and Edward Road, the Shire of Greenough Offices are set on an angle addressing the corner. The building is of brick construction with the hipped tile roof which features several gablets. The building has been extended previously to the south and underwent extensive renovations to the rear in recent years.

The Shire of Greenough Offices were designed by Architect Lewis Eves and built in 1971 by the Geraldton Building Company. The building was officially opened on 6 March 1971 by the Hon Sir David Brand, KCMG, MLA. Extensions to the building were opened on 22 March 1991 by Gordon Garratt, the Shire President. These extensions were designed by Architects Eastman and Poletti and built by F.J. & D.K. Ashplant. Further extensions have been constructed by the Geraldton Building Company to the design of Eastman and Poletti. (Source: Building Plaques)
