- Children and Schooling Programme (Mt Magnet)
- Community Volunteer Service
- Emergency Relief
- Homelessness Services (Housing First Support Service)
- Men's Health and Wellbeing Centre (Men's Hub).

Centacare currently manages 16 programs and employs 45 staff & 20 volunteers.
