Dear Mr Brun,

An emergency meeting of the Community Group of Greenough was convened last night to address the recent actions of the GGHS.

A number of motions were passed.

I wish to formally advise you of the resolutions that pertain to the mediation process and the proposed formation of a new board of management for the Greenough Pioneer Museum.

1. Motion moved by Ron Bradfield, 2nd Jan Featherby – that the CGOG move a vote of no confidence in the GGHS. Motion was passed unanimously.
2. Motion moved by Alex McKinnon, 2nd Gary Martin – That CGOG write to the CEO of the City of Greater Geraldton informing that CGOG will be withdrawing from the mediation process forthwith, and requesting that council re-open the lease of the Greenough Pioneer Museum for public tender. Motion was passed unanimously.

For your reference we have also resolved to seek urgent legal advice regarding the Maley Bequest and the housing of the Collection. We will write to the GGHS separately on this matter and keep the City advised.

So, as delegated, I now formally advise you that the CGOG is withdrawing from the mediation process and request that you put to council CGOG's request to council to re-open the lease of the Greenough Pioneer Museum for public tender.

It is our intention to apply for the lease of the Greenough Pioneer Museum.

I assume this will be advised to all members of the City of Greater Geraldton Council and we await advice from you on next steps.
