The Ice Rink

Think ice skating and most likely you'll visualize an indoor, darkened, chilly warehouse sized rink. In many places in the world ice skating is an outdoor activity, on real lakes, ponds and outdoor rinks. Its an atmosphere guaranteed to be an experience second to none.

On a water front or a town centre, any open space available makes the perfect canvas for a spectacular looking ice floor. The rink can be covered by an open walled marquee (recommended over summer months) or can be open-aired to create a unique outdoor skating experience.

The Ice Rink.

The standard measurement for the rink is 14m by 25m and the foot print is approximately 20m by 40m. The rink size can be tailored to your requirements.

It needs a flat surface (within 10mm) to be built on; the surface can be leveled using a boxed sand base or an integrated floor can be installed. The height of the ice floor from ground level is no more then 10cm. The rink is surrounded by 1m high safety boards.

The rinks power requirement is a 300KVA transformer with 3 phase 400amp fuses. It is connected to a 20'ft chiller unit (size of a 20'ft shipping container) and an external pump with a base measuring 1.8m x 1.2m.

The Ice Rink.

The availability of the ice rink is a minimum of 4 weeks for each location.

Standard pricing inc. skate hire

Adult: \$20 Children (U.16): \$15

Students: \$15 (with student ID)

Family Concession: \$50 (2 adults & 2 children or 1 adult & 3 children)

The average skate time is expected to be 2 hours with a maximum of 4 hours per person. A maximum of 200 skaters (15m by 35m rink size) are allowed on the ice at one time, allowing an average of 1300 skaters per day.

Targeted groups.

Children/ families: The family concession makes ice skating an affordable family outing and a new exciting first time experience for children.

Walk-up crowds will be a significant portion of the customer base. With no skating periods enforced there will be no waiting times, enticing passing public to skate.





Setup & Pack down

Temporary fencing is erected surrounding the site during setup and pack down times. Four days is required either side of the operational periods for the construction/deconstruction of the ice floor.

The ice rink equipment is stored and transported in a 40'ft shipping container (using a swing lift truck). The shipping container will be required on site for 2 days prior to setup and 2 days over the pack down period.

Temporary labour staff are employed locally for the construction/ deconstruction under the supervision of one ice technician, qualified by Ice world International. An electrician is required to connect power to the chillers.
