


Which location and design was chosen?

- Midalia Beach was chosen as it received a majority of votes amongst the public survey.
- The infrastructure (toilets, café and toilets are already in place.
- The area is relatively well sheltered from the southerlies and swell, thanks to the port.
- No reef in that area, so no environmental concerns about driving piles through marine reef habitat.
- The seabed there is a mixture of sand ,sea grass and broken rock.
- Car parking in the area is in place however can be expanded if required.
- Over 6k people have joined the facebook page in support of this project.




Sustainability

- A study was recently conducted regarding pile driving around the preferred location.
- Location is situated in a position not to interfere with any other stakeholders.
- The water depth in the preferred location is ideal for the planned structure.
- The planned structure would allow for a anti shark net to be fitted to create a safe swimming sea pool.



Benefits/Advantages for Geraldton

- The design will be an original for Australia and promote an increase visitors and tourism to Geraldton
- Ideal parking at the boat ramp providing accessible walking route to the jetty.
- Increase in revenue for local businesses due to increased foot traffic along the foreshore with visitors encouraged to utilise Geraldton's amazing ocean views.
- ideal opportunity to utilise local companies and people to construct and maintain the facility.
- Encourage the revitalisation of Chapman road.
- The Jetty will help bring the community together no matter of age, creed or ability, the City boasts the 3rd highest population in WA and lots of smaller towns have jetties which are extremely popular with locals and visitors.
- The Jetty for Geraldton would give all Geraldtonians something to call our own.



Potential Costings

- This project would cost around 10m-12m to install.
- An annual upkeep of 80k-90k PA.
- Comparison
- Esperance Jetty completed last year cost 7.5m and length is 417metres all above water level, with annual upkeep cost of 60k-70k PA.
- Geraldton Jetty will be 600metres in length above water level.
- This would provide The City Of Greater Geraldton 4 new attractions:
- A unique Jetty.
- Safe sea swimming pool.
- Safe snorkelling area.
- Fishing area.
