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SUMMARY

The purpose of this document is to present the City's FY2025-26 Capital Program, which comprises:

- \$29.8 million Asset Renewal Program
- \$8.4 million New Capital Program

The City has prepared the FY2025-26 Capital Program based on modelling for real and projected financial scenarios in alignment with the Long-Term Financial Plan.

Four significant projects will still be in progress from the 2024-25 financial year. These are the Walkaway-Nangetty Bridge renewal construction project, the Airport Microgrid new capital construction project, the Olive Street Housing Project and the Maitland Park Green Connect new capital design project.

ASSET RENEWAL PROGRAM

INTRODUCTION

The Asset Renewal Program contains a total of just under **\$29.8 million** to renew existing assets. This amount includes approximately **\$3.6 million** of grants funding:

Regional Road Group funding \$1,500,000
 Roads to Recovery funding \$2,058,255
 Public Transport Authority funding \$47,500

The City has a large portfolio of community assets under its control which form an integral part of providing services to the community. These assets include roads, drainage, paths, bridges, lights, buildings, airport, plant and fleet, coastal infrastructure, parks, and open space recreational assets. The replacement cost of our assets is approximately \$1 billion dollars, with the annual budget allocation associated with renewal of these assets forming a large part of the City's Capital Program.

The City has evaluated the priorities of nominated projects at a project and portfolio level, developing a Program focusing on asset and network condition, risk, and level of service.

The projects listed are subject to change during the year due to potential for unexpected changes in asset condition and priorities requiring a reallocation of funding accordingly.

The following figure summarises proposed FY2025-26 expenditure at a portfolio level.

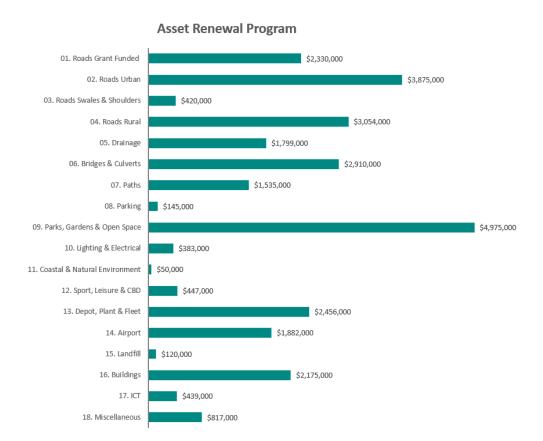

The following figure summarises budget trends for select portfolios over the past 4 years.



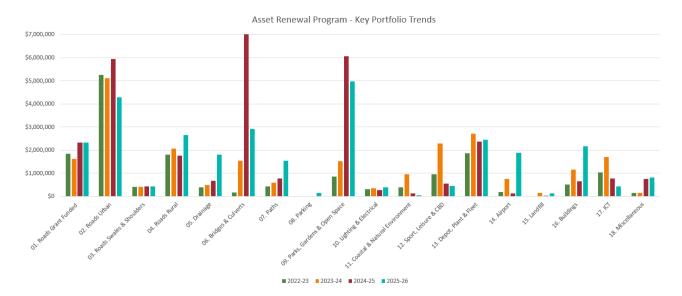

Roads Grant Funded: Two priority roads will be renewed with up to two-thirds of the budget being funded by the State Government through the Regional Road Group. The road projects are Goulds Road and Nangetty-Walkaway Road. The Australian Government Black Spot Program will also fund the first stage of construction of a new roundabout at the intersection of Flores Road & Eastward Road while the State Black Spot Program will fund an upgrade to the Eastward Road and Pass Street roundabout.

Urban Roads: The renewal program for urban roads considers the condition and the hierarchy of the road. Of the 833km of sealed roads in the City, 14.43km will be renewed in FY2025-26.

Swales and Shoulders: The City allocates funding each year towards renewal works on road swales and shoulders, which preserves the road pavement and surface. Each year 50km of swales and shoulders are rehabilitated.

Rural Roads: The City plans to re-sheet 51km of rural roads across the Greater Geraldton region and renew four key intersections.

Drainage: The City is undertaking a number of drainage projects including the renewal of three culverts and the renewing and upgrading of six sumps.

Paths: The City continues to prioritise the renewal of pathways in areas of high traffic or where they pose a risk to the community. The City will renew approximately 1.9 kms of aging footpaths.

Parks: The Parks team continue to renew parks, play equipment, shade structures, and water infrastructure based on the condition assessment of these assets. The renewal of irrigation infrastructure includes the renewal of four water tanks.

Sport, **Leisure**, **and City Precinct**: The pool covers for the Aquarena indoor main and leisure pools will be replaced.

Depot, **Plant and Fleet**: Fleet and plant renewals are based on the ten-year asset management plan and take into consideration utilisation, safety, maintenance and increasingly our impact on carbon emissions.

Airport: The checked baggage screening machine will be replaced and the terminal's main lounge and administration offices will be repainted. The hire car carpark will receive asphalt overlay.

Landfill: The facilities oil storage tanks will be refurbished and a portion of the site's external fencing will be replaced.



Buildings: The City will replace the Aquarena air handling units and extraction system. We will also begin planning to refresh the Visitor Centre at the Geraldton Regional Art Gallery, and the damaged window glass will be repaired and security screens installed on the building.

Bus Stops: The City has received funding from the Public Transport Authority to upgrade a number of bus stops around the City.
