#### 6.4 Department of Biodiversity, Conservation & Attraction

- Murchison experienced 20 fires, Gascoyne experienced 7 fires.
- 16 new crew members trained; one additional truck allocated to Kalbarri, available district-wide. New recruits will be based across Kalbarri, Geraldton and Jurien.
- Busy bushfire season with extended deployments across the state; crews are fatigued.
- Prescribed Burns initiated but significantly reduced due to drought; pending study on plant conditions. Planned for Kalbarri inland weather permitting.
- Fire Programs are underway, with no prescribed burns in the Greater Geraldton area.

- Handheld devices are at the DFES office, awaiting allocation due to programming issues. They will be distributed as soon as practicable.
