6.1 Chief Bush Fire Control Officer - N Johnstone

NOTED: Grain Harvest – currently experiencing ground controller shortages, though not in the Geraldton area. Efforts continue to ensure sufficient personnel are available.

6.4 Department of Biodiversity, Conservation & Attraction

- Appreciation extended to brigades that assisted at the Carnarvon-Mullewa Road and Karara fires.
- Murchison experienced 20 fires.
- 16 new crew members trained; one additional truck allocated to Kalbarri, available district-wide. New recruits will be based across Kalbarri, Geraldton and Jurien.
- Relocated to new 8th Street facility; still addressing power and backup issues.
- Prescribed burns to focus on Kalbarri due to inland drought conditions.
- Blackhawks recognised as a significant asset.
- **NOTED**: Future Blackhawk deployment can be prioritised if preferred.

6.5 Mullewa Central Bush Fire Brigade

• No major updates; new truck performing well with no significant issues.

6.6 Mullewa South Bush Fire Brigade

• Quiet period with a fast harvest; cool and wet weather allowed for sufficient equipment and personnel checks.

• Quiet period, with brigade members assisting at Dongara fires.

7 General Business

- Lovers Lane Firebreak: Completed after the firebreak deadline due to Mitigation Activity Funding (MAF) approval only being received five weeks ago. Top growth removed for fire containment, with plans for ongoing maintenance or inclusion in future MAF grants.
- Additional Firebreaks: Dulchev Way and Verita Road were also delayed but completed under the same MAF funding. Work was done as soon as practicable.
- Starlink Availability:
 - A mini Starlink is available in Chief Bush Fire Control Officer's car.
 - DFES requested portable Starlinks, pending Labor government funding. If approved, they may be installed on fire appliances for operational support.
 - A DFES report suggested Starlink may become obsolete, but this is one opinion, and technology may adapt for mobile compatibility.
 - NOTED: regardless of Starlink claims, the importance is maintaining current brigade communication regardless of future changes.
 - NOTED: Mingenew have brought back their date for burning.
- Acknowledgment: Chief Bush Fire Control Officer expressed thanks for the ready availability of personnel during the quiet period.
