



## **FIRE SUPPRESSION EQUIPMENT**

Pursuant to Regulation 38A & 38B of the *Bush Fires Regulations 1954*, the City of Greater Geraldton gives written notice that undertaking grain harvesting activities shall have the following conditions.

- Provide an operational mobile firefighting unit with no less than 400 litres of water and must be able to draw water from tanks/dams. Must be self-propelled with a two-way radio.
- A separate firefighting appliance is required to be present in any paddock being harvested.
- Minimum six metres of hose (recommended 30 metres) with a controlled nozzle.
- Hitched to a tractor should be a plough, offset disc, speed tiller, stubble muncher or the like, or a grader to be situated in the vicinity of any land or paddock where harvesting operations are being carried out. Required for farming properties over 1000 hectares.
